Chief Constable Neufeld believes strongly in providing top-quality police service to the community through professionalism, innovation, and inclusive leadership that is supportive of employees.

Chief Neufeld began his policing career in 1992 with the Vancouver Police Department. In 1993, he joined the Edmonton Police Service (EPS) where he spent 12 years as a frontline patrol officer, including in Edmonton's diverse inner city where he worked with residents and community partners to address neighbourhood crime, disorder and social issues. He gained experience in undercover operations, incident command, crisis negotiation as well serving as a member of the EPS Public Order Unit working on the G-8 and G-20 summits, Stanley Cup and Grey Cup deployments. Through his career with EPS, Chief Neufeld was promoted through to the rank of Superintendent and spent time in the Criminal Investigations Division, Operational Policy, the Intelligence Section, Professional Standards and in Human Resources.

While in Human Resources, he developed a recruitment strategy for the police service prior to being seconded to the Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) as Director of Investigations.

In 2017 he was appointed Chief of the Camrose Police Service. Camrose, being a smaller community, provided the opportunity for Chief Neufeld to build and foster strong partnerships with staff and with members of the community while working towards the goal of improving the quality of life for all within Camrose and the surrounding area.

In 2019, after two years service as Chief of Police in Camrose, he joined the Calgary Police Service as Chief Constable.

He completed a master's in criminology and police management at the University of Cambridge and the CACP Executive Global Studies program, where he studied international approaches to cybercrime.

Chief Neufeld is a passionate leader, values diversity and advocates for the community. He believes in empowering and inspiring others and recognizes individuals' skills and expertise while acknowledging their value. He firmly believes that by acting with integrity, one fosters high morale and loyalty in others, benefiting individuals, organizations and ultimately, the communities we live in.
